
Number of Children to Achieve SM06 Target - 03 Children

Scorecard Measure 7 – Children Who Do Not Re-Enter Care


Percentage of children who do not re-enter foster care within 12 months of moving to a permanent home.




Scorecard Measure 12 – Separated Siblings





Number of Children Entering and Exiting Out-of-Home Care per Month











Number of Dental Visits to Achieve SM10 Target - 46 Appointments




