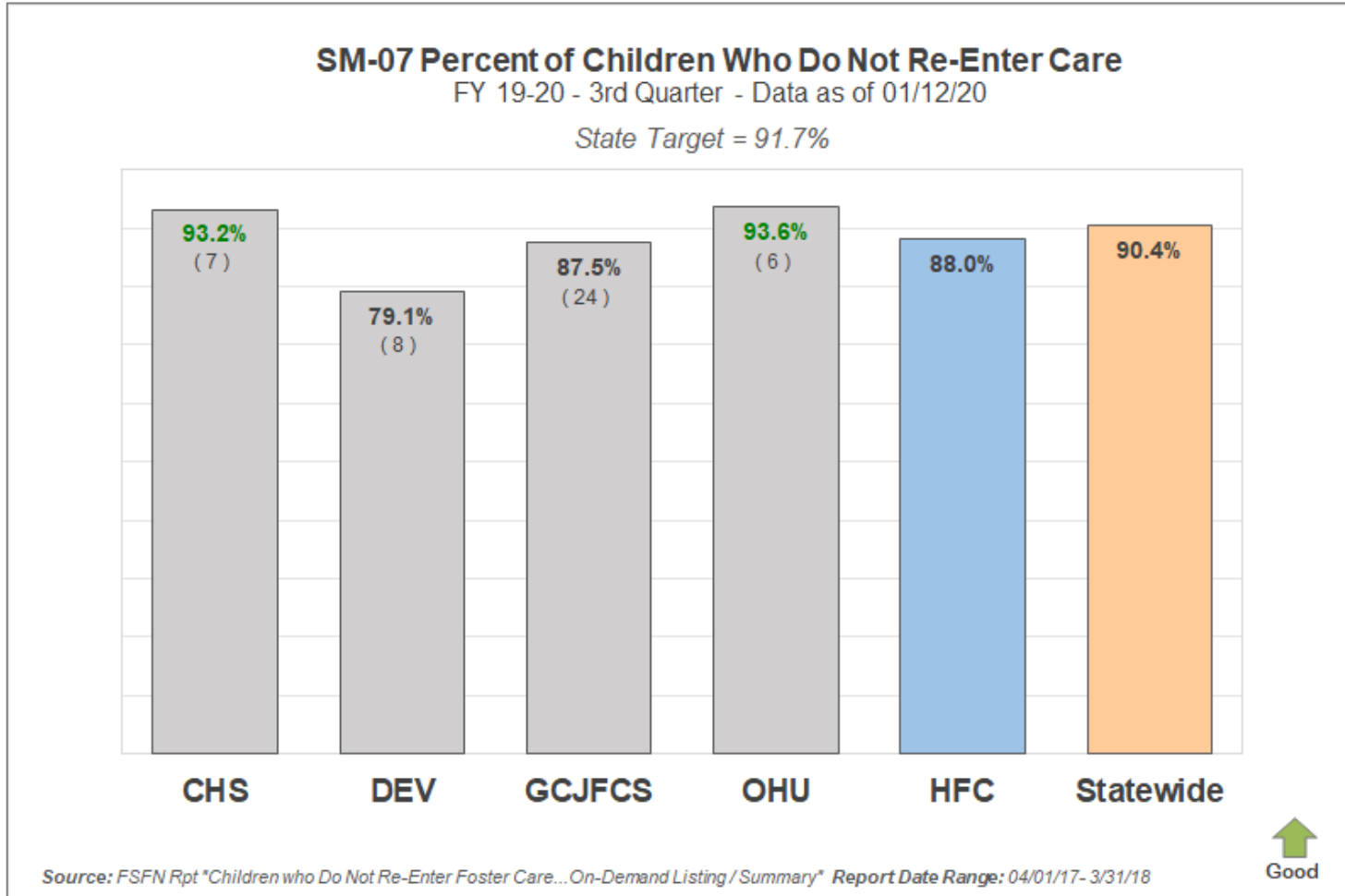

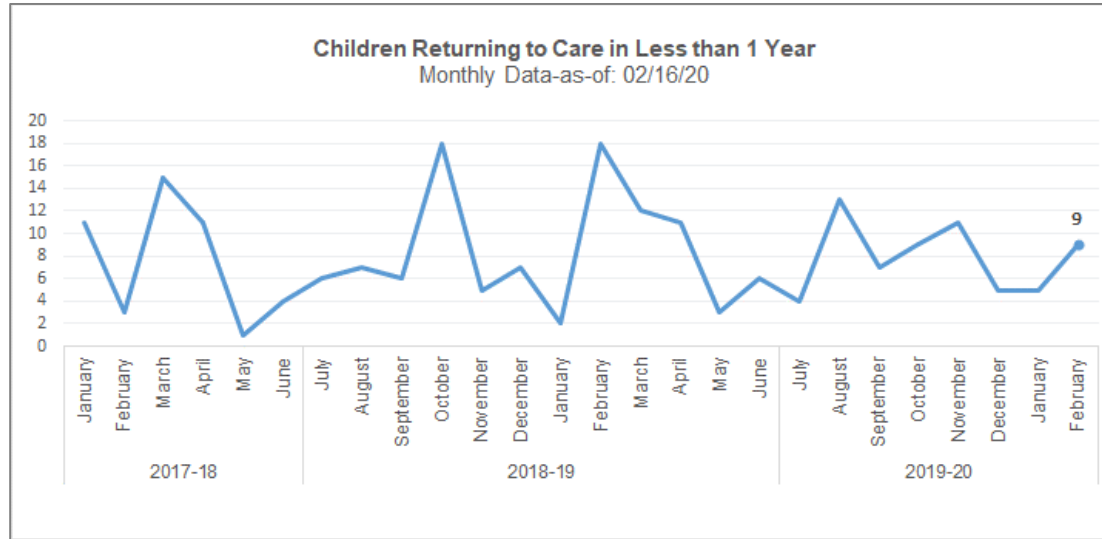

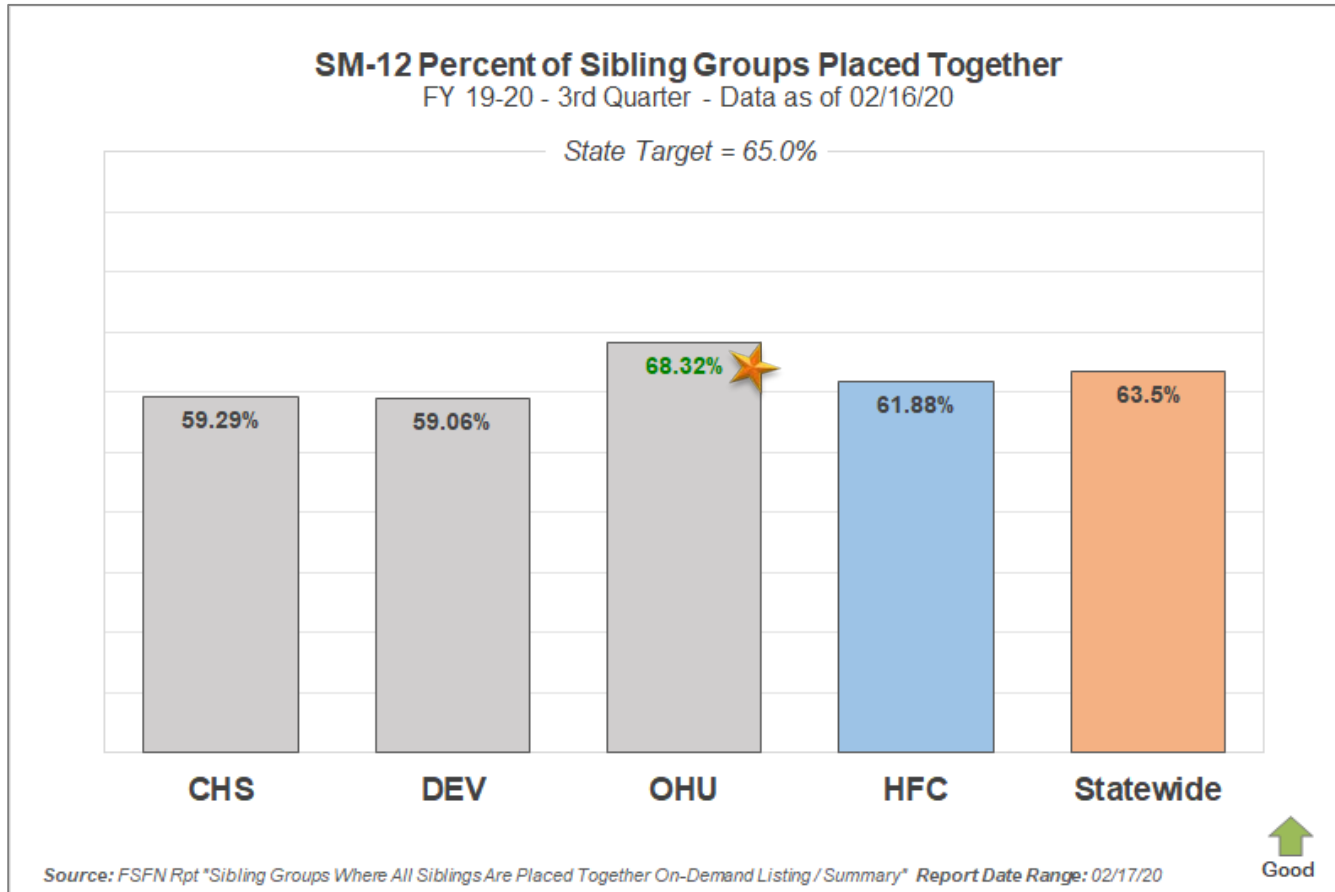

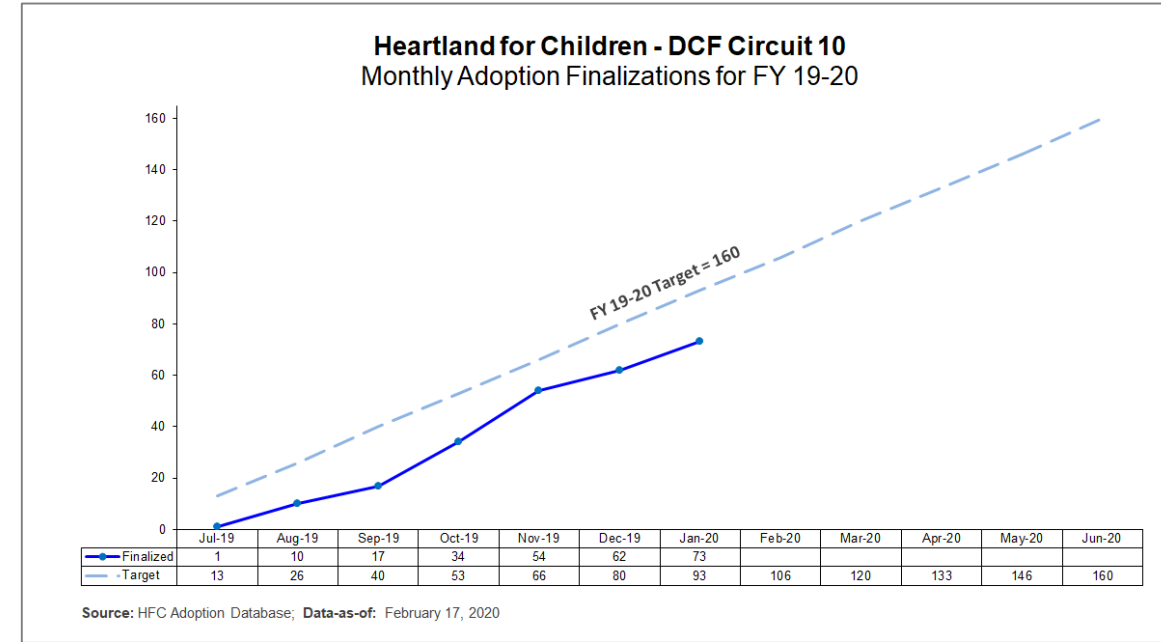

Number of Children Entering and Exiting Out-of-Home Care per Month



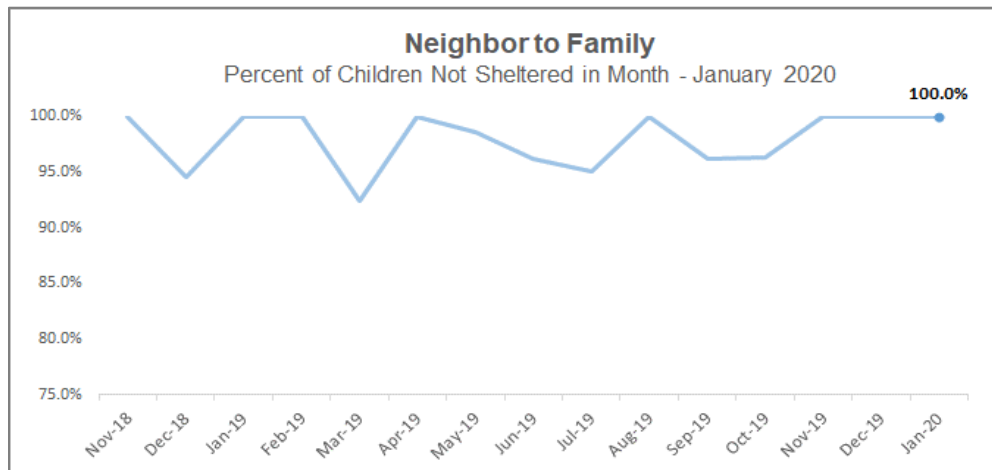

Number of Dental Visits to Achieve SM10 Target – 43 Appointments

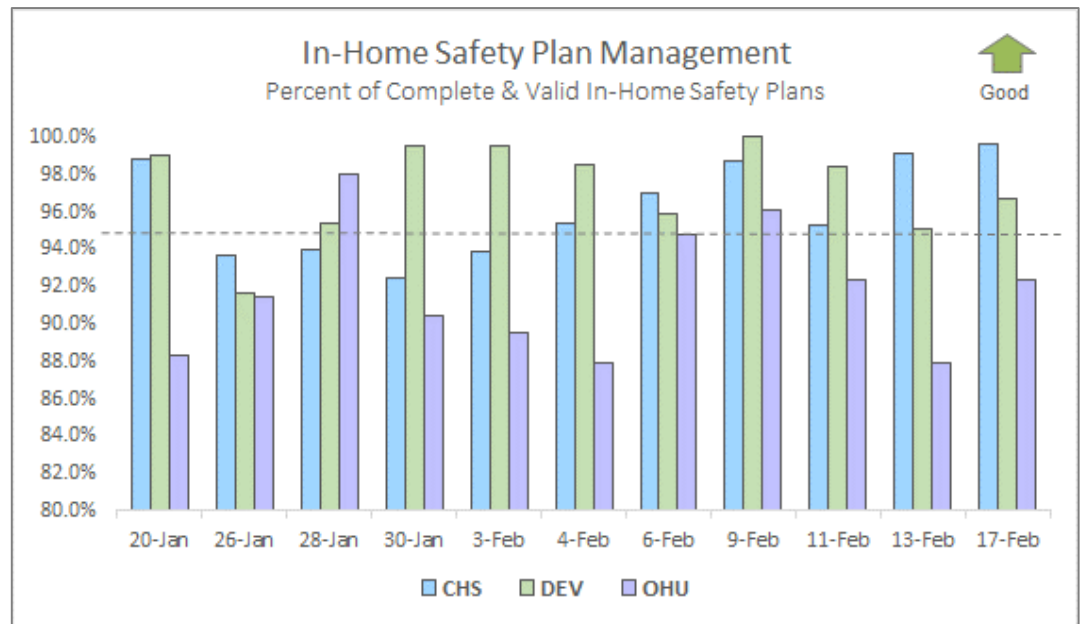

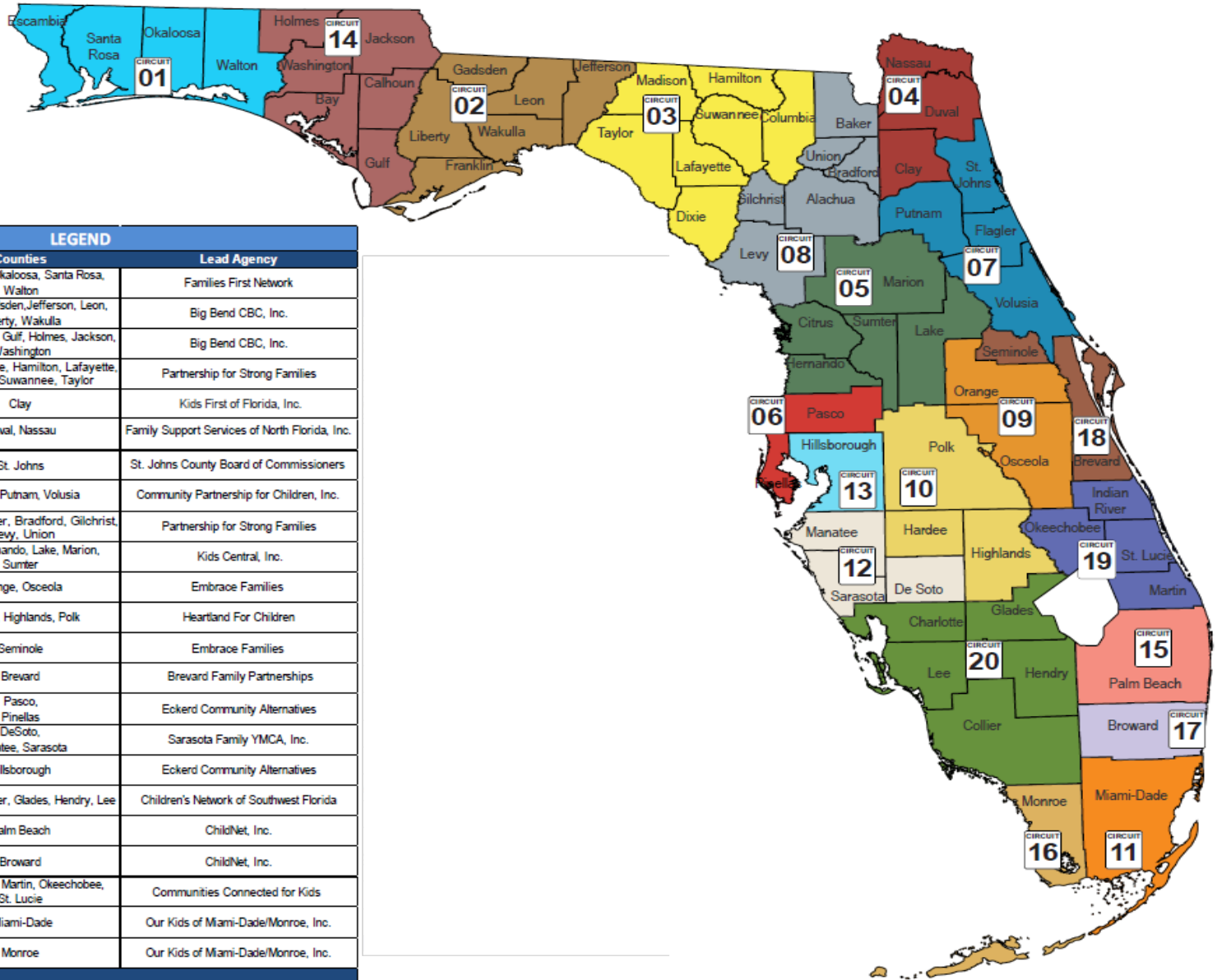
