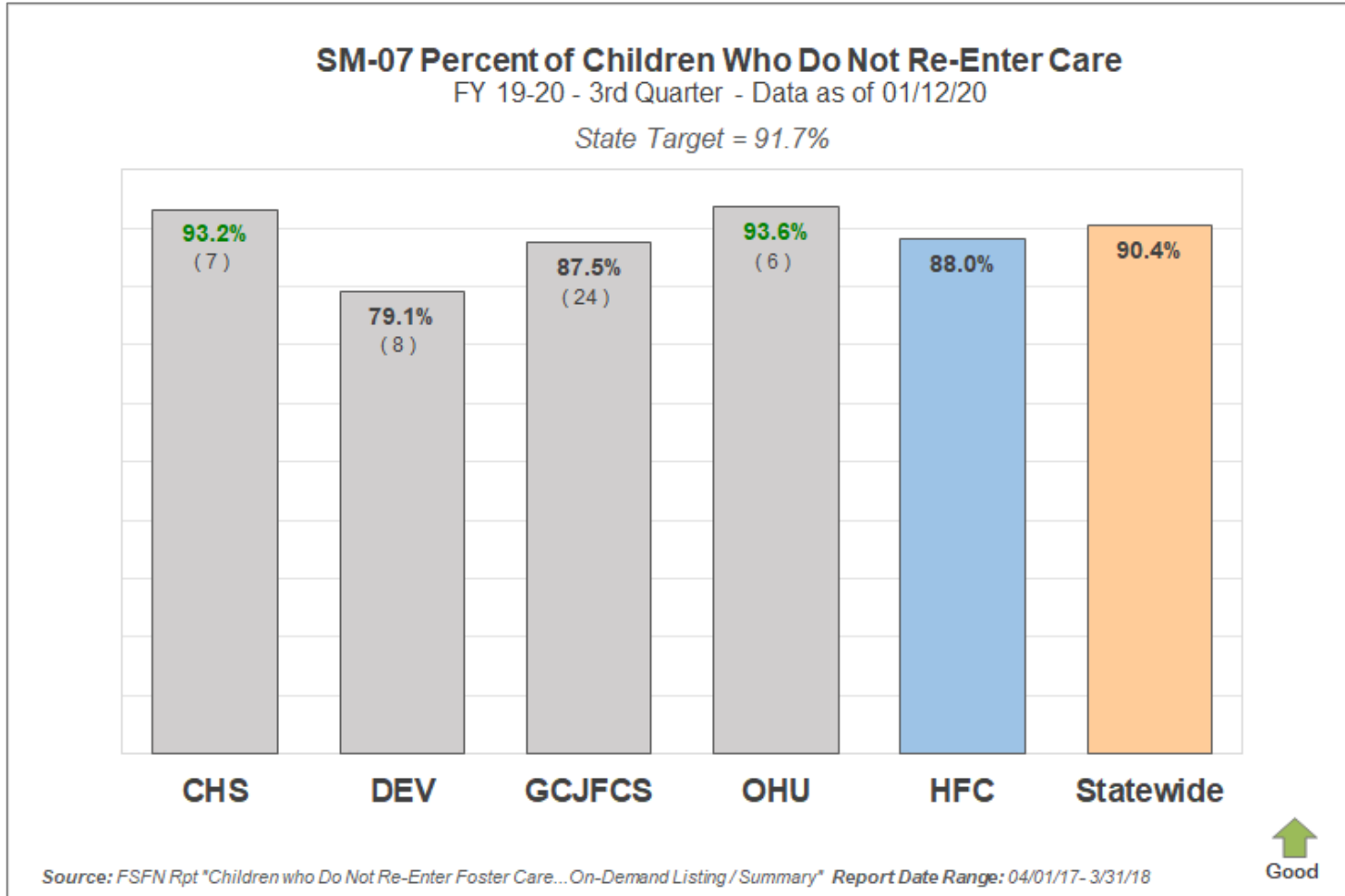

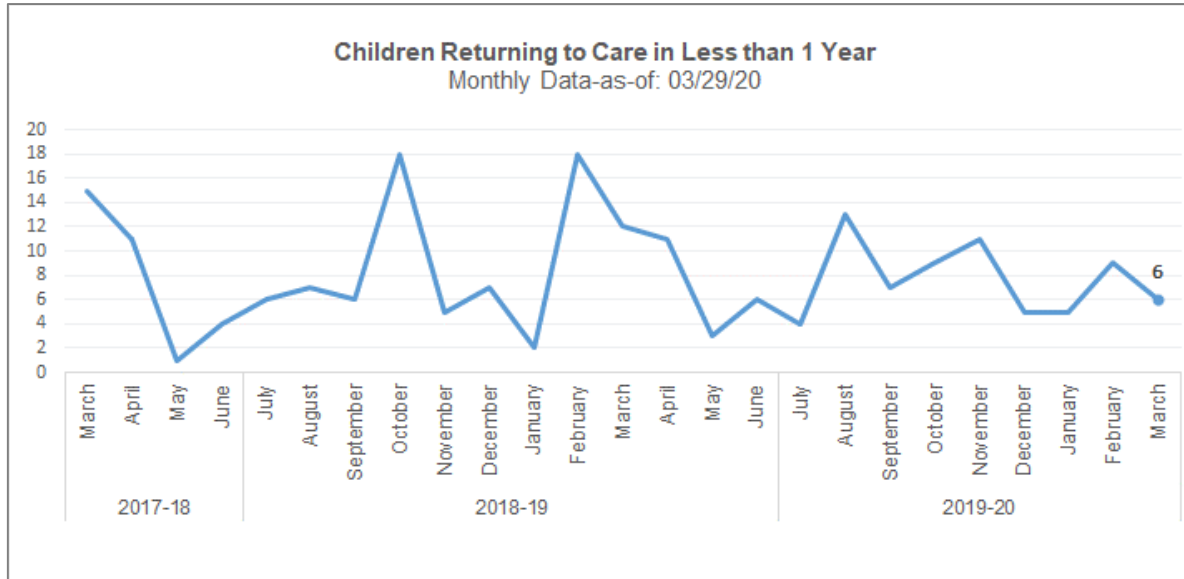

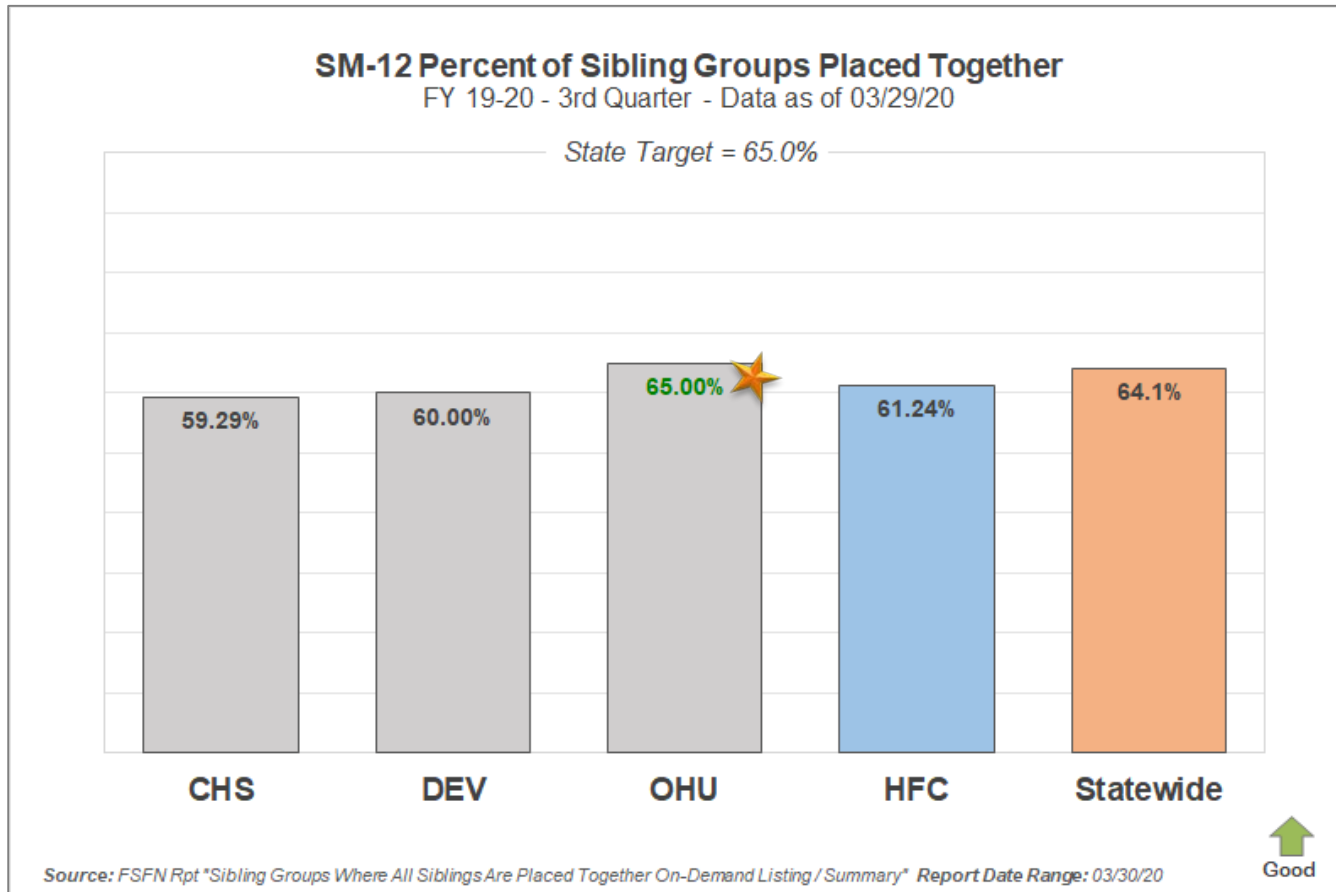

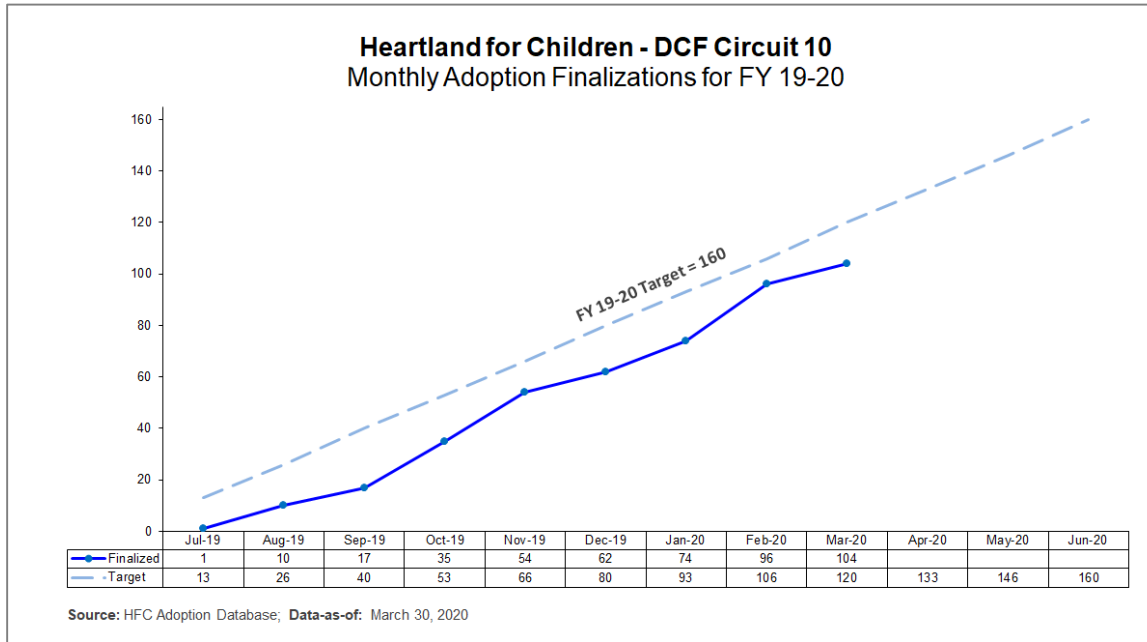

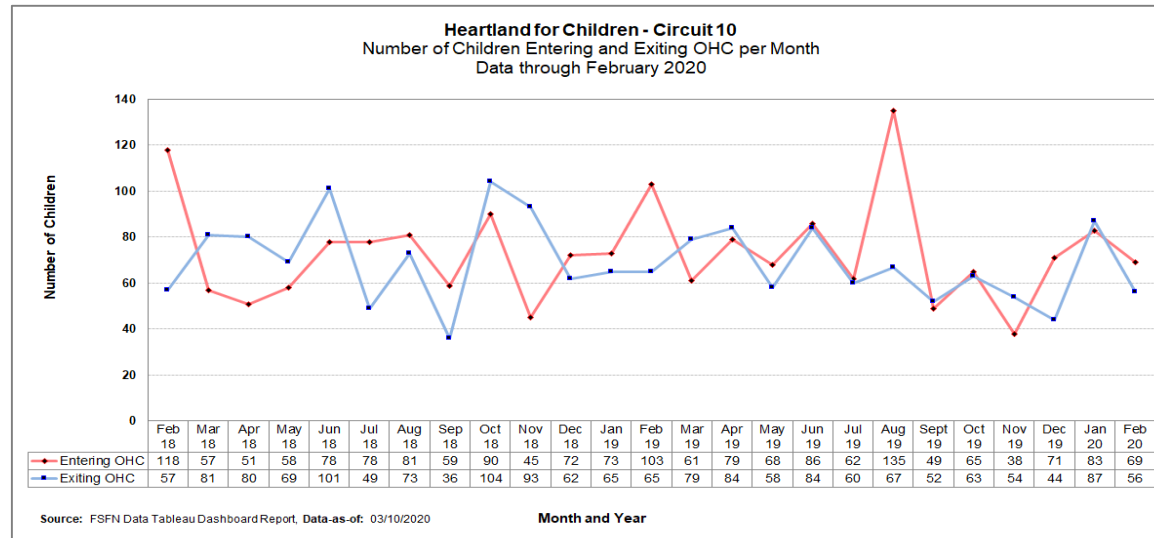

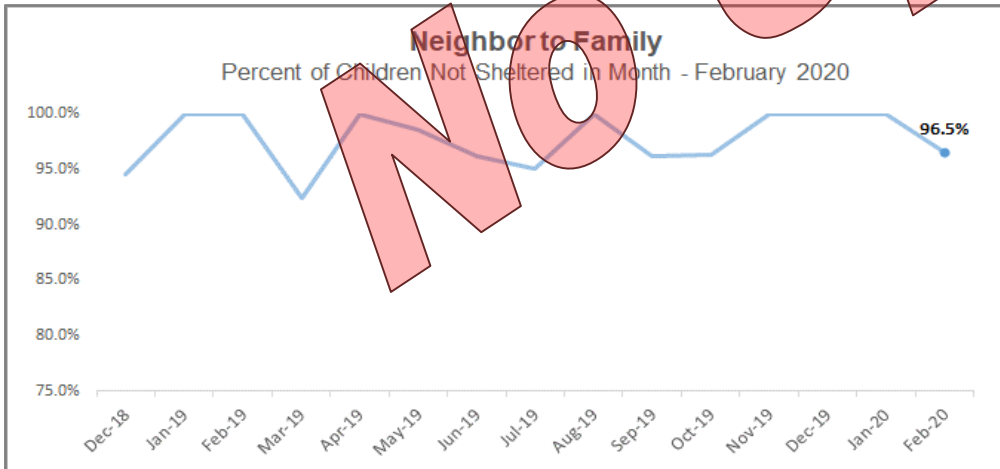

HFC – DCF Circuit 10 Number of Missing Youth as of Reporting Date

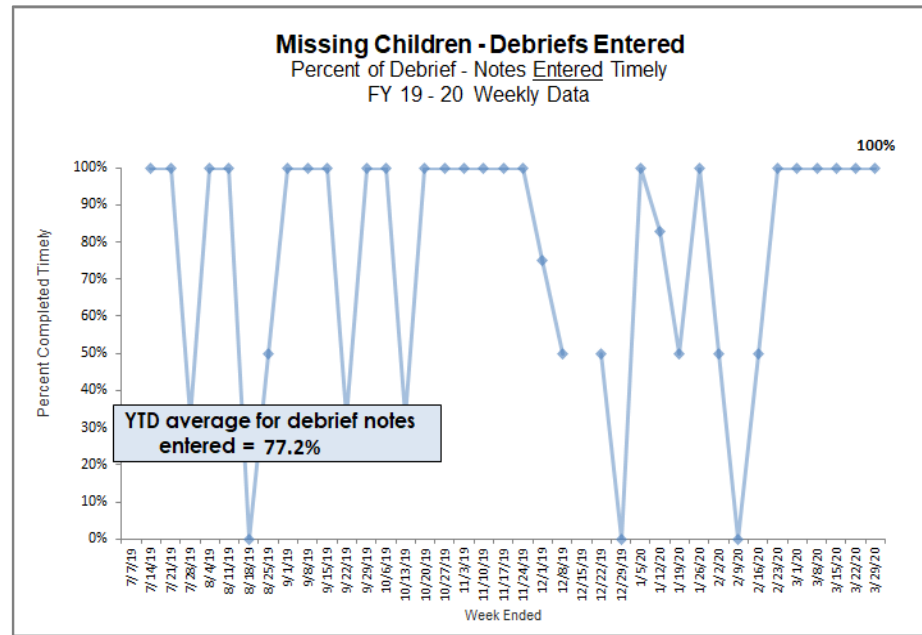
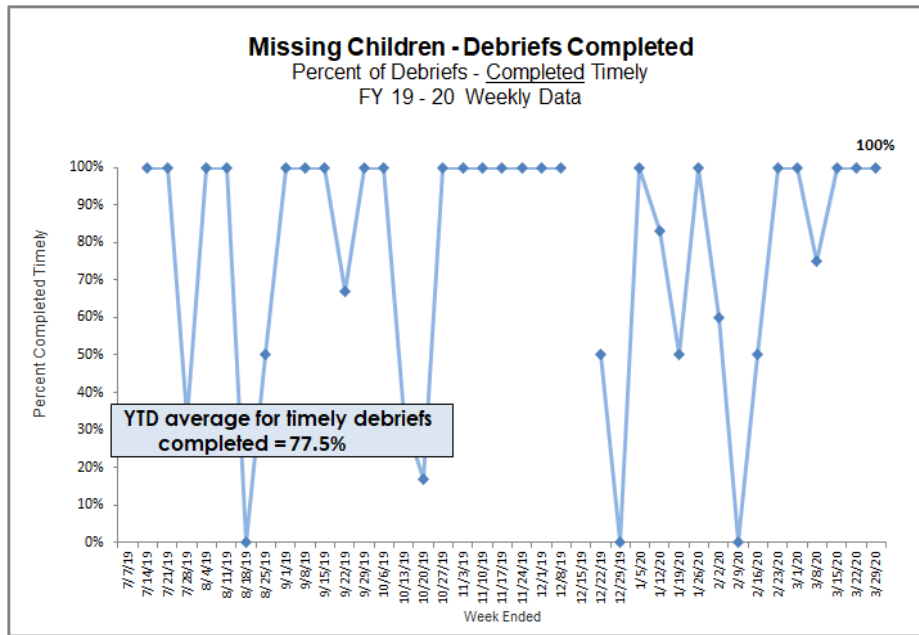

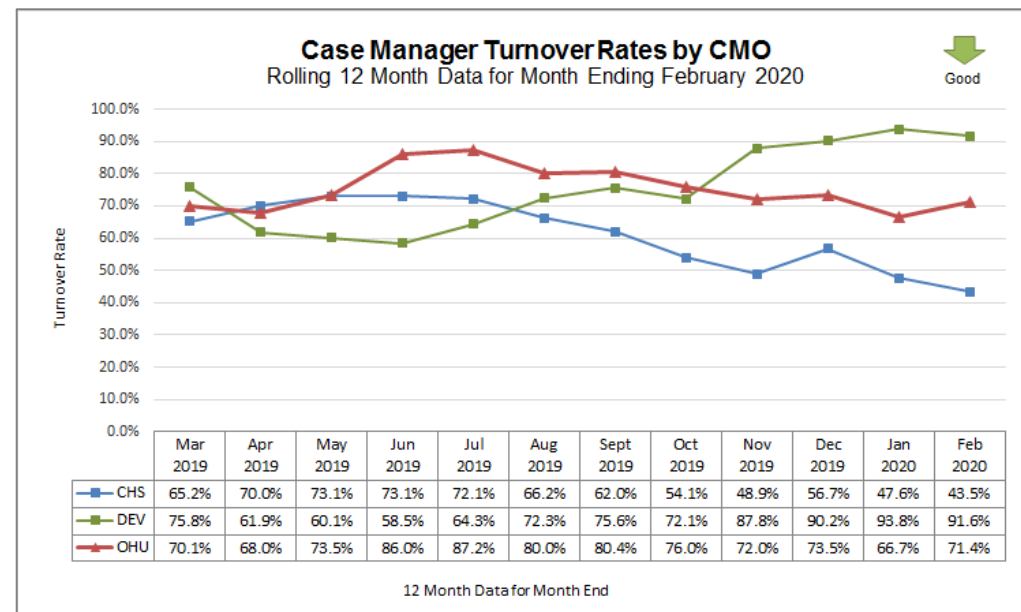

Number of Dental Visits to Achieve SM10 Target – 59 Appointments

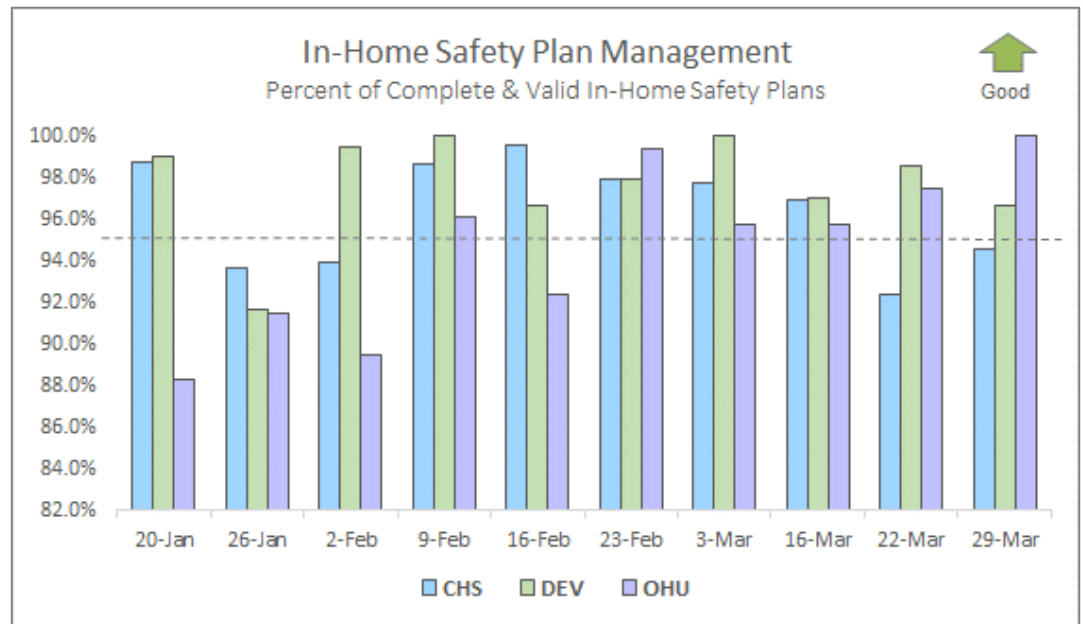

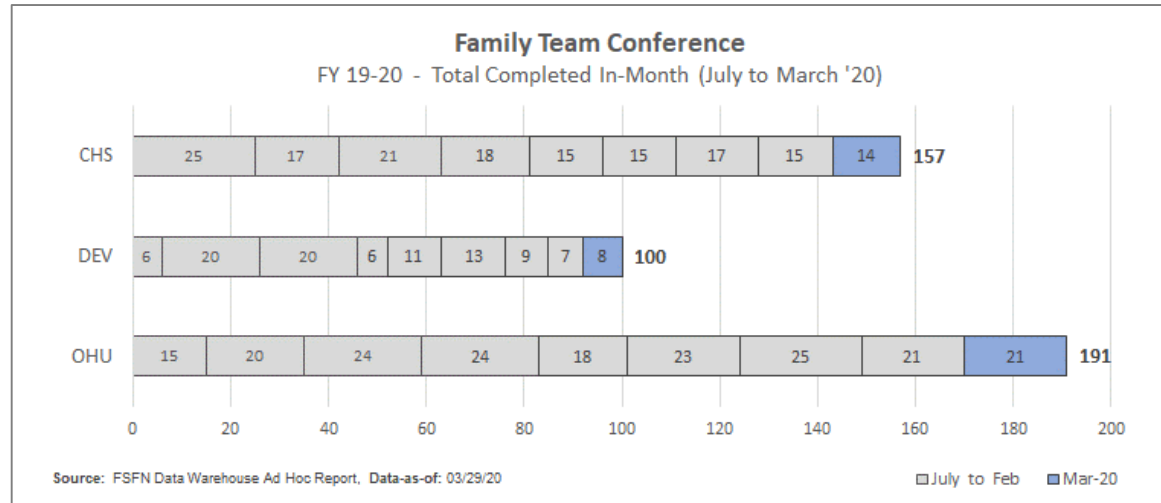

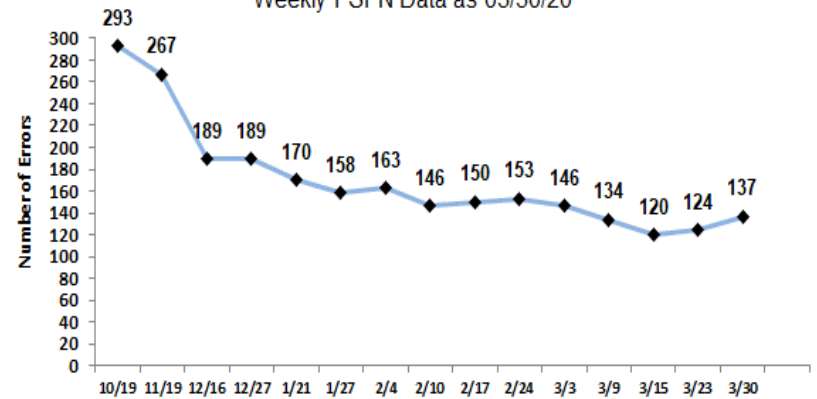

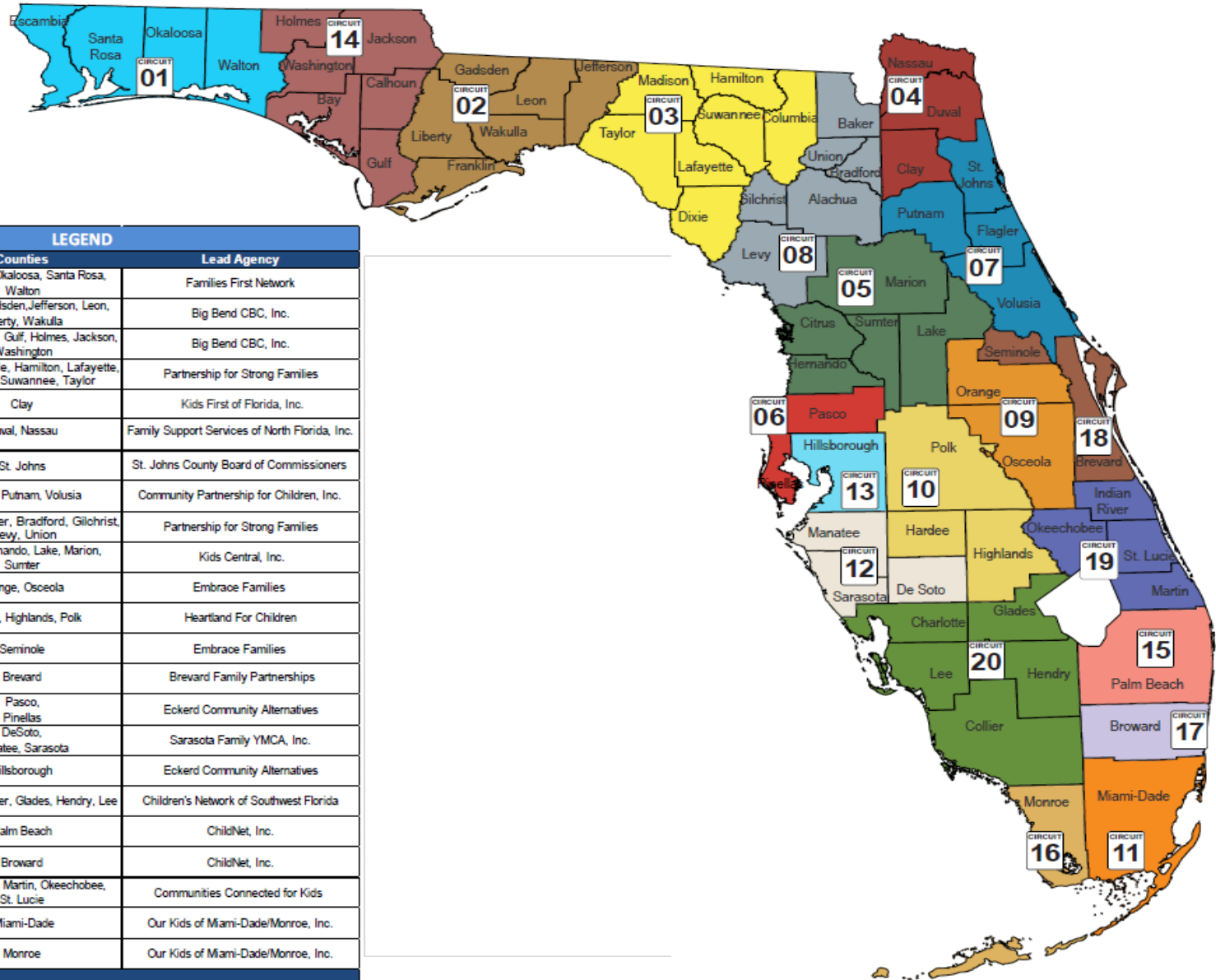
