

Scorecard Measure 7 – Children Who Do Not Re-Enter Care



Number of Children in a Removal Episode Who Have Had a Prior Removal





Scorecard Measure 12 – Separated Siblings








Exit Interviews Timeliness by CMO

HFC Cumulative YTD Timeliness: 77.9%









Exit Interviews Trending by CMO

HFC Cumulative YTD Timeliness: 77.9%





Number of Children Entering and Exiting Out-of-Home Care per Month








Neighbor to Family – Weekly & Monthly Census 17-18 Fiscal Year to Month - Percentage of Children Not Sheltered: 94.9%






