

Children Entering Care between 04/01/15 – 06/30/15 and Achieved Timely Permanency: 109










Adoption Finalizations

Percent of Adoptions Finalized with 24 Months of Removal & Percent of Adoption Goal Met













Average Cost and Length of Stay for Children by Case Management Organization









Removal and Discharge Rates



Number of Children Entering and Exiting Out-of-Home Care per Month










Number of Missing Youth as of Reporting Date













