

#### Scorecard Measure 7 – Children Who Do Not Re-Enter Care


Percentage of children who do not re-enter foster care within 12 months of moving to a permanent home.

Number of Children in a Removal Episode Who Have Had a Prior Removal



#### Scorecard Measure 12 – Separated Siblings


Percentage of siblings groups in out-of-home care where all siblings are placed together.



Number of Children Entering and Exiting Out-of-Home Care per Month








Neighbor to Family – Weekly & Monthly Census 17-18 Fiscal Year to Month - Percentage of Children Not Sheltered: 95.1%




