Number of Children to Achieve SM05 Target – 6 Children



#### Scorecard Measure 7 – Children Who Do Not Re-Enter Care


Percentage of children who do not re-enter foster care within 12 months of moving to a permanent home.







#### **Exit Interview Timeliness by CMO**

HFC Cumulative YTD Timeliness: 68.83%












#### **Exit Interviews Trending by CMO**

HFC Cumulative YTD Timeliness: 68.83%










#### **Adoption Finalizations**

Percent of Adoptions Finalized with 24 Months of Removal & Percent of Adoption Goal Met









#### **Permanency for Children in Out of Home Care**












#### Average Cost and Length of Stay for Children by Case Management Organization







HFC – DCF Circuit 10 Number of Missing Youth as of Reporting Date











#### **Caseload Variance by Month**

Number of Children Opening -vs- Closing to Services during Month (as of 05/31/20)








