Frequent Visitor Legislation

The latest legislative buzz is around the "Frequent Visitor" parts of Chapter 39. It states that a frequent visitor is someone who visits your home for 5 consecutive days and/or 7 days in any given month. The following groups of people who meet this definition will now need to pass backgrounds screens before coming into your home:

- 1. Any individual who provides care or supervision in the home (this includes medical care)
- 2. Any individual aged 12 years and older (other than a child in care)

If these changes apply to your home, please contact your licensing specialist to get this requirement met.

The 60 Second Recruiter

You are standing in line at the grocery store. The person behind you asks you what your "Bonus Parent" shirt means. This a great opportunity to do a little recruitment! All you have to do is smile, tell them a little of your story, give them a recruitment card (make sure your name is on it) and encourage them to call us or go online to learn more about fostering. For your story, include details such as how long you have been fostering, why you got into it and why you continue fostering. Just keep it short; 30 - 60 seconds is all you need to get them interested! If they ask questions you can't answer, tell them that HFC's Licensing Team would be happy to talk with them.
