## WHAT MEDICATIONS ARE AVAILABLE FOR TREATMENT?

#### Methadone

Self pay rate \$15 daily fee

#### **Buprenorphine / Subutex**

Self pay rate \$20 Daily Fee

#### Suboxone

Once per month clinic visit
Self pay rate \$260 for 1st initial admission day;
\$160 for every monthly visit afterwards

#### \*PRESCRIPTION NOT INCLUDED\*

\$230 for office visit; \$30 Drug Screen = \$260 \$130 for office visit; \$30 drug screen = \$160
