# Important General Information

## What is a Primary Care Provider?

A Primary Care Provider (PCP) is a medical professional that practices general medicine; a PCP can be a Doctor, Physician Assistant, or Registered Nurse. They help you monitor chronic conditions and maintain your overall health. A PCP is someone you see when you feel sick and even when you feel well.



## QUICK TIPS



**REGARDLESS OF YOUR CURRENT HEALTH STATUS, IT IS IMPORTANT THAT YOU SEE YOUR PRIMARY CARE PROVIDER AND DENTIST FOR ROUTINE CHECK-UPS EACH YEAR.**

- 1) Know who your PCP is and check that they are listed on your insurance card.
- 2) Get established with a PCP and Dentist
  - Attend your yearly physical/ check ups, or
  - Schedule a new patient well exam
  - *This will help your doctor/ dentist learn about your health needs so that you have a place to go to or a person to call whenever you have concerns.*
- 3) Call your health or dental plans' after-hours support line if you have a concern that is not life-threatening and hopefully avoid an unnecessary trip to the hospital/ ER
- 4) Know what benefits your health and dental plan offer and how to access them
- 5) Some medications and services need to be pre-approved by your health or dental plan before they will pay for them
  - If your doctor or a hospital orders something new for you...
    - Ask them if it needs prior approval, or
    - Call your health or dental plan for more information.



# WHAT IF....

## ...I move out of Florida?

If you move out of the state, your Medicaid will likely be closed. But if you return, you can get your Medicaid back.



### Under 21?

Call your case manager or the agency that manages your case. They can help you get your information updated with Medicaid.

### 21 or older?

Apply through ACCESS Florida  
*They are the agency that manages your Medicaid.*

## ...I stay in Florida but move to a different county?


You may need to change:

- Your health or dental plan depending on which are offered in your county.
- Your Primary Care Provider (PCP), your pharmacy, and other doctors or providers that you were seeing, including your dentist.

If you change PCPs, call member services at your Health Plan to make sure you are covered!

Stay in contact with your caseworker/ the agency that manages or managed your case. They can help to make sure that your Medicaid coverage stays open and all of your information is correct.

## Under 21?

Call your **case manager** or the Independent Living department at the agency that manages your case. They can look it up for you/ get you a copy. **If you know your social security number, you can also call ACCESS FL at 1-866-762-2237.**

Call the agency who has been managing or managed your case. Your agency has a team of Nurses and Behavioral Health Specialists who can assist you with your medical and behavioral health needs.





## ...I WANT TO FIND A NEW PCP?


